Scholarship Application Instructions

You must be a U.S. citizen, a resident of Gilmer County, GA for at least a year, a high school graduate (or GED) to be eligible. There is no age limit. Scholarship funds are available for up to **four (4) semesters** but are not available for any advanced degree beyond Bachelors.

1. **Complete the Scholarship Application.** It is in PDF format. Be certain to answer all questions and that all information is correct and up to date and legible.

2. Applicants currently enrolled in a college must also provide:

- a. A transcript of current school credits.
- b. Documentation from college's financial aid office of all financial aid received along with an estimation of your annual expenses.
- c. A current FAFSA data report. https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/fafsa

3. Applicants NOT currently enrolled in a college must also provide:

- a. Proof of acceptance and date of intended enrollment from the college.
- b. Documentation from the college's financial aid office of all aid for which you are eligible along with an estimation of your annual expenses. The school will provide this information.
- c. A current FAFSA data report. https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/fafsa
